The FAA has announced that the remote tower system at **Leesburg Executive Airport** is "operationally viable" and authorized its continuing use, although final certification of the Saab system is not expected until 2024.

An agreement with a developer of an industrial park near **Frederick Municipal Airport** will require the developer to ensure that trees do not interfere with airport flight paths.
