Q&A with Kyle Herbig, AAAE Vice President-Customer Solutions

Q. How did you first get interested in business aviation, and what is the best part of your job?

Q. What would you tell your high school self to be prepared for your career?

Have patience; listen more and speak less.

Q. What interesting fact about you or event/activity you participated in that was remarkable to you?

Business aviation has allowed me to travel throughout the world and meet interesting people in many industries. Growing up in a smaller community in the Midwest, I never thought I'd have the opportunities I've had.
